GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Clubs are automatically entered in District 24D’s Achievement Contest. A Governor’s Achievement Contest Award will be presented to any Lions club achieving over 10,000 points. A first, second and third place plaque will be presented to the top 3 Lions Clubs achieving the most points (net) per member based upon the total club membership as of June 30, 2016 and gross points for the 2016-2017 year. A first, second, and third place plaque will be presented to the top 3 Lions Clubs achieving the most points (gross) as of June 30, 2017.

Line items A1, A2, A3, A4, A5, A6a, A6b, A6c - MANDATORY - must be completed on time to qualify for District Achievement Award

Questions concerning points should be addressed to the District Achievement Chairperson. Controversies will be resolved by the District Governor. Clubs **MUST** notify the District Achievement Chairperson of any errors or omissions prior to the next report being published. Clubs will be recognized for their accomplishment at the District meeting at the Fall Conference or the 1st Cabinet Meeting in 2016-2017. Club Secretaries: The official Achievement Report is the only form that will be accepted for this program. No other format will be accepted. Please total all points earned on the monthly Achievement Report Form before forwarding the report to the Achievement Program Chairperson.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SECTION D:

Club may claim up to maximum points during the year for each line item, based on total membership as of June 30, 2015. The total amount contributed must be stated on the Achievement Report.

- D1 Line Item D1 is a designated charity that the District Governor may announce from time to time in an attempt to help a specific project or function of the District. The DG may also impose a designated time limit, point value, or contribution limit.
 - D2-D6: donations are based on a per member basis up to the maximum points allowed for that line item.
\$1/member=200 pts, \$2/member=400 pts, \$3/member=600 pts, \$4/member=800 pts, \$5/member=1,000 pts
 - D6: Donations of cash or items for bidding will earn a club 1 pt for each \$1.00 donated up to the maximum pts for the year.
 - D7: Donations earn a club 10 pts for each \$1.00 donated (\$25 earns a club 250 pts, \$50 earns a club 500 pts).
 - D8-D27: donations are based on a per member basis up to the maximum points allowed for that line item.
\$1/member=100 pts, \$2/member=200 pts, \$3/member=300 pts, \$4/member=400 pts, \$5/member=500 pts
- note 1: Purchase of a fellowship or award is covered in Information/Fellowship & cannot be claimed under this section.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SECTION E:

- note 2: Line Item E1 - E4: Donations earn a club 2 pts for each \$1 donated (\$10 earns a club 20 pts, \$50 earns a club 100 pts.)
- note 3: Line Item E5 - E6: Donations earn a club 10 pts for each \$1 donated (\$10 earns a club 100 pts, \$50 earns a club 500 pts.)
